## DO THE RIGHT THING: Wise Things People Do To Bless Their Lives

### **TEACHER'S GUIDE**

session

LEARNING OBJECTIVES Like the last session, our goal is to examine some of the practical instructions to be found in Ecclesiastes. In this session we focus on things we should DO that will bring blessing and benefit to our lives.

#### PAGE-BY-PAGE TEACHING GUIDE

- Page 30 Have the students read and prepare this worksheet before coming to class. At the beginning of class, take several minutes to discuss what they recorded for each passage. The point to be emphasized is that wise men are very careful to listen to the instruction and rebuke of others. Make the point that if we want to be wise, we need to take to heart some of the practical instructions Solomon shares with us in Ecclesiastes.
- Pages 31-32 The students should prepare these sheets before coming to class. When you reach this point in class, break your students into teams and have them discuss their answers for each passage studied. Students should note any additional information they learned from their team discussion. After the teams have had some time to talk this over, go over each verse with the entire group. Each team can share what they have learned with the class. You should spend the rest of this class period working on this first set of verses.
- Pages 33-34 This worksheet should be used for a second class period. You can follow the same approach that you used for pages 31-32.
